

THE P.C.E.D. SCHOLARSHIP FOR NONTRADITIONAL STUDENTS

Purpose of scholarship: To help and encourage people in Phillips County who want to upgrade their work skills by furthering their education.

Scholarship: This scholarship will range from \$100 to \$2,000 per year, will be paid directly to the learning institution for tuition and/ or books; will be for those attending a Juco, Vo-Tech school, or any one to four year program including those using on-line courses; and can be renewed for one year upon receipt of a transcript from the previous year to show that the student is in good standing and reapplication.

Eligibility: The person applying must have been a resident of Phillips County for at least one year or recently returned to Phillips County from active military service. He/she must be able to provide work and/or personal references. This scholarship will be based on current work success and personal references, general conduct, and personal ethics rather than on high school transcripts. The applicant must describe his/her plan for furthering their education by answering the questions below. High school seniors and students currently enrolled in a post-high school program are NOT eligible for this scholarship; application will be considered one year after high school graduation for those who meet eligibility requirements.

To Apply: Contact the office for the Phillips County Economic Development Board located in the Fischer Building in Phillipsburg for an application. These will be available in March and should be returned no later than May 1 to: PCED Scholarship Committee, Box 604, Phillipsburg, KS 67661. Personal interviews may be arranged after applications have been received.

Selection: The recipients will be selected by the Scholarship Committee under the auspice of the Phillips County Economic Development Board.
